



REGULATORY UPDATE: TRAFFIC

REMINDER:

Effective November 17, 2018, a transportation data collection moratorium will go into effect for New York City's five boroughs. The moratorium will remain in effect until mid-January 2019. Projects subject to City Environmental Quality Review (CEQR) are required to use traffic and pedestrian counts reflecting typical background conditions. The traffic and pedestrian conditions during the moratorium period are not representative of typical conditions. Therefore, it is important for projects subject to CEQR with tight deadlines to complete any transportation data collection prior to this moratorium. The moratorium is also applicable to projects subject to CEQR requiring vehicle classification data for Air Quality and Noise analyses.
