

REGULATORY UPDATE

INDOOR ALLERGEN HAZARDS (MOLD AND PESTS) LOCAL LAW NO. 55 IS NOW IN EFFECT – MARCH 2019

Property owners, managers, facilities and maintenance personnel, architects, engineers, and all others involved in the management and maintenance of a New York City property, including multi-dwelling units, are now required to comply with Local Law No. 55, which went into effect on January 18, 2019.

The new requirements include:

- Annually inspect units for indoor allergen hazards, including mold, mice, cockroaches, and rats.
- Provide an annual notice and NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) pamphlet to prospective and current tenants.
- Use integrated pest management to address pest infestations.
- Use the recommended safe work practices to address mold and underlying defects. "Class C" violations require an
 inspection by a NYS-licensed mold assessment company and remediation by a NYS-licensed mold remediation
 company.
