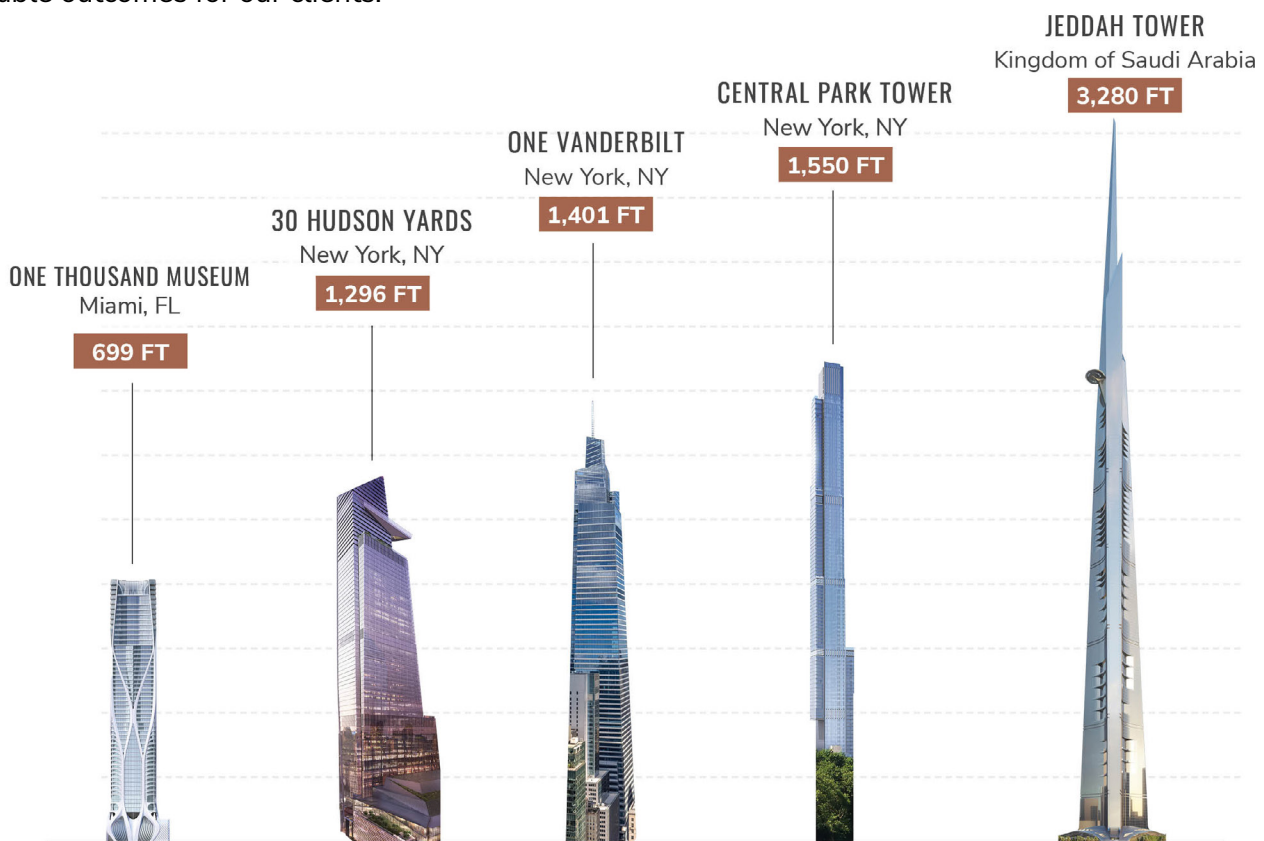


### Boston Zoning Commission Passes Rezoning to Allow Taller Buildings Downtown
